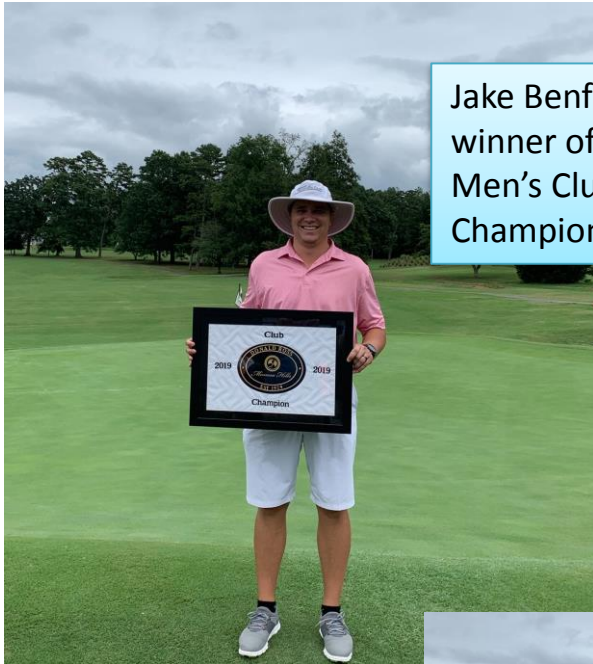

On the Course:

The aerification, top-dress and verti-cut of the bentgrass greens should have been completed the last week of August. This process is necessary to remove thatch (organic matter) and replace with sand in order to keep organic matter levels to USGA standards. We have those values measured by a reputable lab every year. Last year the heat and high humidity continued through September and the greens suffered at a time when they should be recovering. Let us hope for normal temperatures. As we get cooler nights the bentgrass roots will start to rejuvenate and the greens will firm up. It is an agronomic certainty that for the months of July, August and September that bentgrass is an inferior surface compared to the new ultra dwarf bermudagrass varieties that exist today.

The first application of the fall pre-emergent herbicide was hopefully completed by Sept. 1. The main target is poa Annua (annual bluegrass) and chickweed, but many other weeds are controlled as well. The second app will occur in early November and will carry us until the spring application in February.

Thank you all who support the Mimosa Hills Preservation Donors Club. About 38,000 sq. ft of bermudagrass sod was laid on holes #3 and #7, with most of it on #3. After the shock of cutting, transport and laying, the sod has greened up very well. That is with some fertilizer and a bunch of water (very little from 'Mother Nature'). Our pond level shows it. What a view from the tees on #3 and #18. Down the road, once established, hole #3 will play so much better. And in the fall, less leaves.

Preservation Club Update – September 2019

The Club is currently fundraising to improve hole 15 which needs work on both the left and right sides of the hole. The work will include additional irrigation and drainage control, some tree trimming and the application of sod where needed.

As you can see, the tree, limb removal and stump grinding are complete for holes 3, 7 and 18. The majority of the work has been done along the left side of hole 3, allowing grass to grow and eliminating the erosion which as occurred. The Bermuda grass sod has been installed, with lots of watering while it takes hold. This work to improve our wonderful golf course is courtesy of the Mimosa Hills Preservation Donors Club donations. We think you'll agree that these holes will look and play much better.

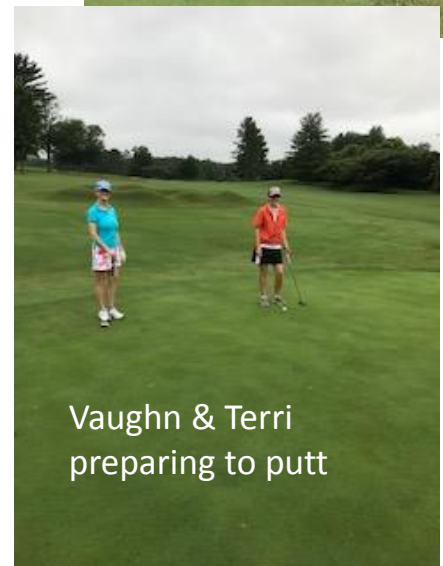
