Member Spotlight:



Loy Ray and Doris Burris

L.R. and Doris Burris have been active loyal Resident Family Golf members of Mimosa Hills since 1955. They have been active golfing members longer than any other members of the Club. Mr. Burris was born in Gastonia, and Mrs. Burris was born and raised in Valdese. Mr. Burris moved to Valdese in 1945 with his family. Mr. and Mrs. Burris were married in 1952. Mr. Burris' father owned and operated the Rock Drug Store.

Mr. Burris eventually took over the drug store from his father. The family business has now been passed on to Mr. Burris' daughter and son-in-law, Marianne and Bruce Cannon, who are also members of the Club. Mr. and Mrs. Burris were kind enough to sit down with us and share some fond memories of Mimosa Hills.

When asked how he was exposed to golf, Mr. Burris stated that after graduating from UNC and becoming a pharmacist, he was in the Army and was stationed in Battle Creek, Michigan at Perry Jones Hospital from 1952 to 1954. It was there that he played golf, mostly at Marywood Golf Course.

When asked what his handicap was when he was playing best, Mr. Burris replied that "I think I was probably a 5 or so". He indicated that his best score at Mimosa was "67", and that his greatest accomplishment was winning the Parent-Child Tournament at Mimosa with his son, Ray. He said that they were paired with Billy Joe and Chuck Patton at the event. The other accomplishment he was proud of was playing with his Dad and winning their flight at the National Lefty-Righty Tournament held at Mimosa.

Mr. Burris said that aside from his family, Ed Kaplan was his favorite golf buddy, and that later on he really enjoyed playing with Lee Riddle. He indicated that he was fortunate to play golf and spend time with Joe Cheves and Billy Joe Patton, and that for whatever reason "Billy Joe really took to me, I think its because he recognized my passion and love for the game." Mr. Burris told a funny story about Mr. Cheves and Mr. Patton. They all went to a tournament in Statesville, and it was really cold. Mr. Burris took sweaters, jackets, and everything you could think of to stay warm. Mr. Cheves looked at him before they started to play and said, "you've got over \$100.00 worth of equipment and a 10 cent swing." By the end of the round Mr. Cheves had on one of his sweaters and Mr. Patton had on one of his jackets.

Mrs. Burris was asked if she ever tried to play golf. She said that she did not have any interest as she was too busy raising 5 children. She did say that her Father, Ben Pons was a member at Mimosa Hills and that she really enjoyed coming to the Club for meals and to do her Christmas shopping.

Mr. Burris does not play golf as much as he once did, but he and Mrs. Burris still comes out and enjoys the dining room for lunch and dinner. He said that he is feeling better now and plans to start hitting balls again soon. Mrs. Burris said he could "only have one bucket, I don't want him to overdo it." The Burris's do often come out to watch their 2 grandsons, Will and Wes Cannon, who are members of Mimosa Hills play in tournaments. Mimosa Hills is lucky to have the Burris family as members! We hope that they will continue to be with us for many years to come.

Updated Golf Rules for Guests

On May 21, 2019, the Mimosa Hills Golf Club's Board of Governors adopted a change in the Rules Governing

Use of the Course.

14. Guests. Green fees for guests shall be charged to the sponsoring member or may be paid by credit card or cash. Play for a guest of any member is limited to twelve (12) guest rounds per year, excluding tournaments.

For the remainder of 2019, play for a guest is limited to seven (7) times. Questions regarding this rule change should be referred to the Pro Shop.

The golf course is closed for non-tournament play until approximately 6 pm. The practice facility will open at 2 pm for members.

The golf course will close to non-tournament play at 9:30 am on Friday morning. The practice facility will remain open until 5 pm.

Saturday

The golf course and practice facility will be closed to all non-tournament play on Saturday.

The golf course and practice facility will be closed until approximately 2 pm each day.

On the Course:

The last half of May was very dry and hot. We hate to see summer start so early for our bentgrass greens. Some were asking throughout Memorial Day weekend "how are the greens holding up with the mid 90-degree heat"? The response was that the greens are doing fine being freshly aerified and the humidity low. The problem is we have potentially 12 more weeks of summer ahead of us and likely high humidity (bad for disease pressure).

Overall the double aerifying the week of May 6 was successful. We did our standard aerification early in the week, double verti-cut midweek then the 'Dryject' process was done on Thursday. For the week, roughly 60 tons of sand was incorporated into our greens. The dried sand for the 'Dryject' process had fertilizer and a soil amendment blended in. The additional holes filled with sand plus the fertilizer and amendment should help our greens perform better for the summer. See pictures below.

The entire golf course was fertilized the week of May 20. We sure could use some rain to more thoroughly water it in. As mentioned in last month's newsletter, CGA agronomist Bill Anderson visited Mimosa Hills on April 30. Click here for the report.

Please remember to fix your ball marks by pushing down and forward not lifting upwards which tears the roots. Also, please rake your bunker disturbances and sand divots and/or beat in from all sides with your golf club.
