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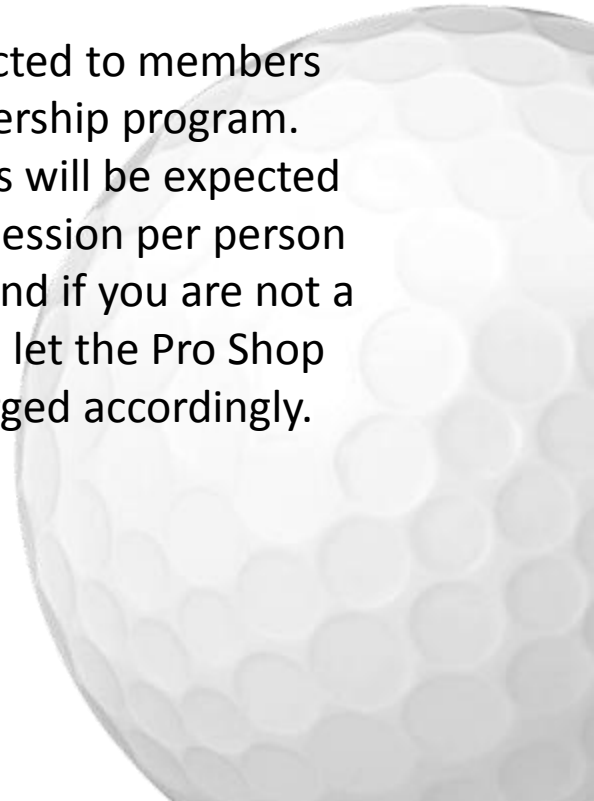

With only 2" of rain for March, it seemed like a dry spell compared to last year and the beginning of this year. The course is finally 'not wet'. The average temperature for March was 49.68 degrees which is one degree over average and basically the same as February 2019. What is interesting is that we had six frosty mornings in Feb and nine in March. Although the soil temperatures dictate the greening up of our bermudagrass; the frosty mornings do not help and slow the process down. We did dodge some mid to late March temperatures dipping into the mid to lower 20's which can really hurt the bermudagrass health as well as flowering bushes and trees. A big issue for peach growers a little bit south of us. Speaking of flowering trees, the old rule of thumb for summer weed control in our area is that crabgrass germinates when the Redbud trees are blooming and goosegrass germinates when the Dogwood trees are in bloom.

It was nice to finish the bermudagrass aerification on March 21, now we just need warmer temperatures. The second solid tine aerification, light verti-cut and light topdress is scheduled for Tuesday, April 9th. Everything went well in March and I believe the process had little disturbance with play and yet a great benefit for the greens in many ways. As stated in previous newsletters, the week of May 6th will be the double aerification and heavy sand topdressing.

Once again I would like to thank all who support the Mimosa Hills Preservation Donors Club. The projects are much needed improvements that the normal operating budget cannot assume the expense of. I am in constant contact with the tree contractor to begin tree removal on holes #3 and #7, so we can prepare the bare ground areas for grassing. This work will be accomplished with the funds donated in 2018. The proposal for 2019 is to add irrigation, drainage, top soil, and grass bare areas for hole #15. Every little bit helps, so please contact the office to see how you can pledge.

The yearly visit with Carolinas Golf Association agronomist Bill Anderson is scheduled for Tuesday, April 30, 2019. Mr. Anderson evaluates our maintenance programs, special projects, facility, equipment, and overall course conditions. He visits golf courses all over North and South Carolina with varying grasses and budgets. The board members are encouraged to participate for this visit to discuss any questions they have. Please let us know if you have any questions you may want discussed.
